Last week, KU Physics Major Alex Spielman attended an international geophysics conference ([SAGEEP](#)) to present his work with Geology faculty Dr. Laura Sherrod on mapping the flow of groundwater in the Schuylkill Headwaters, an area severely impacted by Abandoned Mine Drainage. Alex used electrical resistivity tomography and temperature flux in West Creek to determine zones of seepage of from the stream channel into the subsurface mine system. His work was part of a Growing Green Plus Grant awarded in 2014 and is being used by the [Schuylkill Headwaters Association](#), the [Schuylkill Conservation District](#), and the [United States Geological Survey](#) to help determine an appropriate remediation plan for the region.
